

Change of Major to BA in Family & Consumer Sciences
Department of Consumer & Family Studies/Dietetics

The BA in Family & Consumer Sciences is not impacted and invites current students to submit a change of major request to the Department during the following time periods:

- For Spring term: August 1-October 1
- For Fall term: January 1-March 1

Prerequisites. Before being accepted to the major students must have:

Nutrition/Foodservice Systems Management

- minimum 2.0 GPA
- minimum grade of C in Chem 101/102

Child and Family Studies

- minimum 2.0 GPA
- completion of all lower division GE requirements:
 - Area A: English Language Communication and Critical Thinking
 - Area B: Scientific Inquiry and Quantitative Reasoning
 - Area C: Arts and Humanities
 - Area D: Social Sciences
 - Area E: Lifelong Learning and Self-development (LLD)

All students who have been accepted as a change of major to FCS may start major-only classes the semester following approval of the change of major. Students accepted in the fall semester may begin major courses the following spring; students accepted in the spring semester may begin major courses in the following fall.

Process

1. Type your information on the Change of Major form
2. Print and submit form along with proof of completion of prerequisites to the Department Chair for signature
3. Submit signed form to Student Services
4. Meet with an advisor in your emphasis to prepare a Graduation Plan
